Programs to Assist Foster Youth in Transitioning to Independent Adulthood

Foster Youth to Independence (FYI) Voucher Program

- Description: This program provides dedicated rental assistance to support youth exiting
 foster care who are at risk of homelessness, as well as those who have become
 homeless after leaving foster care. Public Housing Agencies partner with Public Child
 Welfare Agencies to offer housing assistance to eligible youth.

Family Unification Program (FUP)

- **Description:**Administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), FUP offers housing assistance to youth aging out of foster care who are at risk of homelessness. The program provides Housing Choice Vouchers to eligible individuals, facilitating access to stable housing.

Foster Care Independence Act

- **Description:** This act provides states with flexible funding to assist youth likely to age out of foster care at age 18. It supports programs that help youth obtain a high school diploma, explore careers, receive vocational training, and develop life skills necessary for independent living.
